



Guest Writing Guidelines

What I Ask Of You:

- Posts should be written from a Christian perspective, offering encouragement to all ages, with a “me too” perspective.
- Submit only original pieces that haven’t appeared elsewhere, including your personal blog.
- Only one piece should be submitted for consideration.
- Posts should be between 500-700 words. Please include quotes and sticky phrases (Max. 140 characters) to promote post on Twitter. If including scripture, please limit to (1) and include translation.
- Posts should be checked for correct grammar and spelling.
- Please upload your post in a Word document, including your name and post title.
- If your post is accepted, you will be asked to include a 50-75 word bio along with a photo of yourself and desired social media links for me to highlight below your post.
- Upon publishing, your post will have proper author crediting, but cannot be republished elsewhere, including your blog. Do post an attention grabber on your blog with links to my blog so readers can read your entire post.
- Readers are going to want to connect with you, so on the day your post is published, please plan to have a presence to share comments and engage with readers.

What You Can Expect From Me:

- There is no need to provide a graphic, as I will include optimized social media graphics.
- I will format your Word document to fit desired post style and post bio and picture of you, also listing links to your social media sites.
- I reserve the right to edit your post and add internal links.
- The day your post is published, I will email you the permalink to share across your social media sites. I will share and promote on my social media sites so readers will be able to enjoy your message and connect.
